## A mummy of a teenage girl found

A wooden coffin of a teenage girl has been found near Luxor in Egypt. It is 3,500 years old and though it doesn't belong to a pharaoh or any other royal, the mummy in it was decorated with precious jewelry. The archaelogists think the girl was 15 or 16 years old when she died and her body was covered with thin sheets. They could not tell who she was or why she died, but her jewelry was in perfect condition. There were copper-plated earrings, two rings made of bone and blue glass, four necklaces made of blue ceramic beads and one with ceramic and green glass beads. One of the necklaces was specially beautiful. It was made of 75 pieces of carved semi-precious stones such as amethyst, carnelian and amber with many amulets, including one of Horus, the Egyptian god of the sky.

The archaelogists think that the jewels are part of the girl's wedding accessories. Her grave is one among many exciting things, including a 4,000-year-old funeral complex, the team has found during their excavations.


